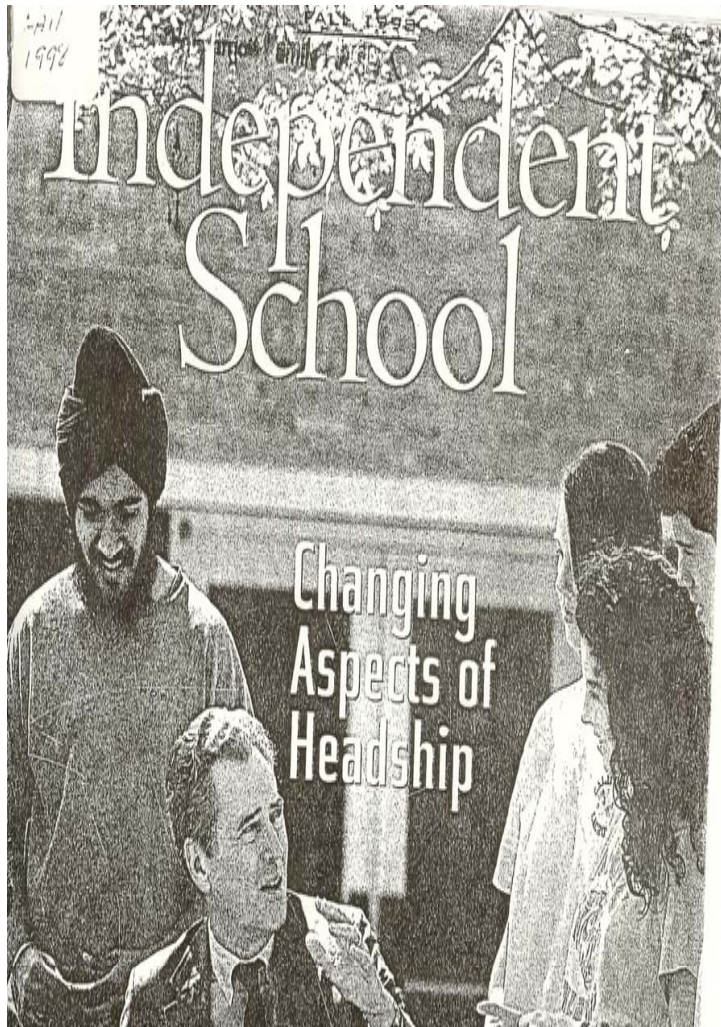


Changing Aspects of Headship
